EUNIC, with its commitment to dialogue, cultural relations and fundamental freedoms, is deeply saddened by the brutal attack at the French satirical magazine Charlie Hebdo. « This is a direct attack on Freedom of Expression, and we all have a responsibility to react and reaffirm the importance of a free debate and free media. EUNIC will continue to work in close relationship with culture and media professionals, in our efforts to build trust and relationships between people and societies », says Annika Rembe, President of EUNIC.

On 19 January 2015, Paul Dujardin, BOZAR Director-General, mentioned EUNIC in his speech *Culture in a globalised world: the art of conviction* for the New Year Reception of VIRA (Vereniging Voor Internationale Relaties). Dujardin said they are working with More Europe and the members of EUNIC as part of the consortium "Culture in EU external relations", a European Commission initiative. He also added that this study was given extra budget by the Juncker Commission in the perspective of 2020, and that the consortium is ready to start work.
